BOARD OF EDUCATION  
JOINT MEETING WITH ANDREW  
FEBRUARY 10, 2020

The Andrew Board of Education met for a joint board meeting with the Maquoketa School Board of Education on February 10, 2020, in the Ansel Briggs Conference Room at Andrew Community School. Also present were Maquoketa Curriculum Director Tara Notz, Superintendents Chris Hoover and Chris Fee, Board Secretaries Kristy Haxmeier and Karen Kilburg, and Sara Millhouse from the Maquoketa Sentinel Press.

President Shauna Barton welcomed the Maquoketa Board.

Tara Notz spoke to the board on the different curriculums they are using in the core subject areas and how they were working out.

The Whole Grade Sharing agreement was discussed and it was the consensus that everything was working well, students coming from Andrew Community School are very well prepared and are involved in many activities and clubs. The 28E agreement was also discussed. It was presented that changes to the 28E agreement would be presented at a later meeting for the Board to review and consider approval. These changes will include a change from a reimbursement billing method to an annual invoice method for the calculated rate due. The facility committee language will be replaced with language to note that each year at the annual joint meeting, an overview will be provided on the projects that the dollars were used for.

Tony Portz also highlighted a grant opportunity funded by Farm Bureau for Ag in the classroom.
