SPECIAL MEETING
MAY 11, 2021

President Hayward called the special meeting of the Maquoketa Community School Board to order on May 11, 2021 at 12:04 p.m. via Zoom. Directors Hayward, Roeder, and Miller were present. Directors Creegan and Herring were absent. Board Secretary Haxmeier and Superintendent Hoover were present. Others were in attendance via Zoom.

MOTION #169:20/21: M/Miller, 2nd/Roeder to approve the following consent agenda as presented: 3 ayes, 0 nays motion carried.

GENERAL BUSINESS OF THE BOARD

MOTION #170-20/21: M/Roeder, 2nd/Miller to approve the rates as presented below for health, dental and vision premiums for the plan year July 1, 2021- June 30, 2022. 3 ayes, motion carried.

- Dental-moving out of pocket maximum to \$1,000 (up from \$750); No premium rate increase
- Health Insurance Monthly Premiums (rates have not been increased since 2015-16)
 - Single plan: \$524.00 (+\$17.00)
 - Family plan: \$1,310 (+37.00)
- Vision-increase monthly rates as follows:
 - Employee \$8.23 (+\$.77)
 - Employee + 1 \$13.17 (+\$1.24)
 - Employee + Children \$13.45 (+\$1.27)
 - Employee, Spouse, Children \$21.68 (+\$2.04)

MOTION #171-20/21: M/Miller, 2nd/Roeder to approve the Master Contract with the Maquoketa Education Association for the 2021-22 school year. Increases include a \$400 Increase to the Base Salary of Schedule A and a \$400 Increase to Base Salary of the Supplemental Salary Schedule (Appendix B). Overall total package increase for “regular tab” teachers is 2.924%. There was also a Memo of Understanding added to the contract to allow the use of prep time for CTT meetings during the weeks of September 20, October 4, November 1, December 6, January 31, February 14, and April 4. 3 ayes, motion carried.

MOTION #172-20/21: M/Roeder, 2nd/Miller to adjourn the meeting. 3 ayes, motion carried.

Director Hayward adjourned the meeting at 12:10 p.m.
